New York Grain Stocks

ALBANY, NY -- New York's **corn** stored off farms on September 1, 2015 was 2.2 million bushels, up 70 percent from last year's level of 1.3 million bushels, according to Blair Smith, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New York Field Office.

Wheat stored off farms totaled 11.4 million bushels, up from last year's total of 11.2 million bushels. **Oats** stored off farms were 296 thousand bushels, up 57 percent. **Soybeans** stored off farms totaled 114 thousand bushels, up from 78 thousand bushels last year.
