Pennsylvania Hay: Hay stocks on farms totaled 390 thousand tons, up 47 percent from May 2015, but down 81 percent from December 2015.

Maryland Hay: Hay stocks on farms totaled 78 thousand tons, up 11 percent from May 2015, but down 79 percent from December 2015.

Delaware Hay: Hay stocks on farms totaled 2 thousand tons, unchanged from May 2015, but down 90 percent from December 2015.

New Jersey Hay: Hay stocks on farms totaled 20 thousand tons, up 13 thousand tons from May 2015, but down 60 thousand tons from December 2015.

New York Hay: Hay stocks on farms totaled 189 thousand tons, down 22 percent from May 2015, and down 85 percent from December 2015.

New England:

Connecticut: Hay stocks on farms totaled 4 thousand tons, down 43 percent from the May 2015, and down 91 percent from December 2015.

Maine: Hay stocks on farms totaled 26 thousand tons, unchanged from May 2015, but down 81 percent from December 2015.

Massachusetts: Hay stocks on farms totaled 14 thousand tons, up 100 percent from May 2015, but down 75 percent from December 2015.

New Hampshire: Hay stocks on farms totaled 6 thousand tons, down 14 percent from May 2015, and down 86 percent from December 2015.

Rhode Island: Hay stocks on farms totaled 1 thousand tons, unchanged from May 2015, but down 83 percent from December 2015.

Vermont: Hay stocks on farms totaled 35 thousand tons, unchanged from the May 2015, and down 77 percent from December 2015.
