New York 2015 Annual Milk Production Up 2.7 Percent from 2014

The annual production of milk for New York during 2015 was 14.1 billion pounds, 2.7 percent above 2014, according to Blair Smith, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New York Field Office.

Production per cow in New York averaged 22,816 pounds per cow for 2015, 491 pounds above 2014.

The average number of milk cows on farms in New York during 2015 was 618 thousand head, up 3,000 head from 2014.
