Milk production in **New York** during November 2016 totaled 1.20 billion pounds, up 4.4 percent from November 2015. The average milk price received by New York farmers in October 2016, at \$17.40 per hundredweight, is down \$0.40 from September 2016 and down \$1.80 from October a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during November 2016 totaled 877 million pounds, up 2.5 percent from November 2015. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in October 2016, at \$17.70 per hundredweight, is down \$0.20 from September 2016 and down \$1.70 from October a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during November 2016 totaled 219 million pounds, up 1.9 percent from November 2015. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in October 2016, at \$17.70 per hundredweight, is down \$0.50 from September 2016 and down \$1.80 from October a year ago.
