Milk production in **New York** during October 2016 totaled 1.24 billion pounds, up 4.7 percent from October 2015. The average milk price received by New York farmers in September 2016, at \$17.80 per hundredweight, is up \$0.50 from August 2016 but down \$0.80 from September a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during October 2016 totaled 899 million pounds, up 2.2 percent from October 2015. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in September 2016, at \$17.90 per hundredweight, is up \$0.40 from August 2016 but down \$1.00 from September a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during October 2016 totaled 226 million pounds, up 3.2 percent from October 2015. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in September 2016, at \$18.20 per hundredweight, is up \$0.50 from August 2016 but down \$0.80 from September a year ago.
