## Value of New York Grape Production Increases

**Albany, New York** - The value of New York's 2016 grape production totaled \$64.5 million according to Blair Smith, State Statistician of USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New York Field Office. The value of utilized production increased 13 percent from the previous year.

**Grape production** in New York was 171,000 tons, up 18 percent from 2015.

**Fresh grapes** totaled 2,000 tons while 169,000 tons were crushed by wineries and processors.

**Grapes utilized for juice** accounted for 115,000 tons processed with the remaining 54,000 tons going for wine.
