Milk production in **New York** during April 2017 totaled 1.27 billion pounds, up 3.9 percent from April 2016. The average milk price received by New York farmers in March 2017 at \$18.60 per hundredweight, is down \$0.50 from February 2016 but up \$2.40 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during April 2017 totaled 948 million pounds, up 2.5 percent from April 2016. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in March 2017, at \$18.80 per hundredweight, is down \$0.80 from February 2016 but up \$2.40 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during April 2017 totaled 230 million pounds, up 0.9 percent from April 2016. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in March 2017, at \$18.90 per hundredweight, is down \$0.70 from February 2016 but up \$2.40 from March a year ago.
