Milk production in **New York** during April 2018 totaled 1.24 billion pounds, down 2.4 percent from April 2017. The average milk price received by New York farmers in March 2018, at \$15.80 per hundredweight, is up \$0.20 from February 2018 but down \$2.80 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during April 2018 totaled 932 million pounds, down 1.7 percent from April 2017. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in March 2018, at \$16.00 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from February 2018 but down \$2.60 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during April 2018 totaled 223 million pounds, down 3.0 percent from April 2017. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in March 2018, at \$16.20 per hundredweight, is up \$0.30 from February 2018 but down \$2.70 from March a year ago.
