Milk production in **New York** during September 2018 totaled 1.21 billion pounds, up 0.8 percent from September 2017. The average milk price received by New York farmers in August 2018, at \$16.40 per hundredweight, is up \$0.30 from July 2018 but down \$2.40 from August a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during September 2018 totaled 832 million pounds, down 4.3 percent from September 2017. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in August 2018, at \$16.40 per hundredweight, is up \$0.20 from July 2018 but down \$2.90 from August a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during September 2018 totaled 217 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from September 2017. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in August 2018, at \$16.70 per hundredweight, is up \$0.20 from July 2018 but down \$2.40 from August a year ago.
