Milk production in **New York** during December 2018 totaled 1.24 billion pounds, up 2.1 percent from December 2017. The average milk price received by New York farmers in November 2018, at \$17.80 per hundredweight, is down \$0.30 from October 2018 and down \$0.50 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during December 2018 totaled 856 million pounds, down 6.0 percent from December 2017. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in November 2018, at \$18.00 per hundredweight, is down \$0.10 from October 2018 and down \$0.90 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during December 2018 totaled 225 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from December 2017. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in November 2018, at \$18.20 per hundredweight, is down \$0.30 from October 2018 and down \$0.40 from November a year ago.
