New York 2018 Annual Milk Production Down Slightly from 2017

ALBANY, NY - The annual production of milk for New York during 2018 was 14.9 billion pounds, 0.3 percent below 2017, according to King Whetstone, Regional Director of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Northeastern Regional Field Office.

Production per cow in New York averaged 23,888 pounds per cow for 2018, 37 pounds below 2017.

The average number of milk cows on farms in New York during 2018 was 623 thousand head, down 1,000 head from 2017.
