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

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New York Trout Value of Sales Increase 29 Percent from 2017

The total value of fish sales received by trout growers in New York totaled 732 thousand dollars for 2018, an increase of 29 percent from 2017, according to King Whetstone, director of the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service, Northeastern Regional Field Office.

The number of 6”- 12” trout sold during 2018 totaled 75 thousand fish. The average price per pound was \$4.77 during 2018, down \$0.53 from the 2017 price. The total value of sales was 210 thousand dollars during 2018, up from 122 thousand in 2017.



Distributed Trout

Trout distributed for restoration, conservation, enhancement, or recreational purposes; primarily by State and Federal hatcheries, included 2.53 million 6”- 12” fish with an estimated total value of 4.52 million dollars, up 88 percent from 2017. The estimated value of all distributed fish totaled 5.90 million dollars, up 78 percent from 2017.

Trout Losses

Total losses of all trout intended for sale were 59 thousand fish during 2018.
