Milk production in **New York** during January 2021 totaled 1.30 billion pounds, up 0.7 percent from January 2020. The average milk price received by New York farmers in December 2020, at \$18.30 per hundredweight, is down \$1.70 from November 2020 and down \$2.20 from December 2019.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during January 2021 totaled 865 million pounds, down 0.1 percent from January 2020. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in December 2020, at \$18.80 per hundredweight, is down \$1.40 from November 2020 and down \$2.30 from December 2019.

Milk production in **Vermont** during January 2021 totaled 220 million pounds, down 2.7 percent from January 2020. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in December 2020, at \$19.00 per hundredweight, is down \$1.50 from November 2020 and down \$1.80 from December 2019.
