**Maryland** egg production totaled 53.4 million during February 2022, down 9 percent from last year. Production included 52.3 million table eggs, and 1.1 million hatching eggs. The total number of layers during February 2022 averaged 2.35 million, down 7 percent from last year. February egg production per 100 layers was 2,270 eggs, down 2 percent from February 2021.

**New York** egg production totaled 132.9 million during February 2022, down 3 percent from last year. The total number of layers during February 2022 averaged 5.69 million, down 2 percent from last year. February egg production per 100 layers was 2,337 eggs, down 1 percent from February 2021.

**Pennsylvania** egg production totaled 713.0 million during February 2022, up 13 percent from last year. Production included 679.8 million table eggs, and 33.2 million hatching eggs. The total number of layers during February 2022 averaged about 30.0 million, down 2 percent from last year. February egg production per 100 layers was 2,377 eggs, up 15 percent from February 2021.
