Milk production in **New York** during June 2022 totaled 1.31 billion pounds, down 0.2 percent from June 2021. The average milk price received by New York farmers in May 2022, at \$27.10 per hundredweight, is up 8.80\$ from April 2022 but up 8.10\$ from May a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during June 2022 totaled 841 million pounds, down 0.6 percent from June 2021. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in May 2022, at \$27.30 per hundredweight, is up 8.90\$ from April 2022 but up 8.00\$ from May a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during June 2022 totaled 211 million pounds, down 1.9 percent from June 2021. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in May 2022, at \$27.70 per hundredweight, is up 8.80\$ from April 2022 but up 8.00\$ from May a year ago.
