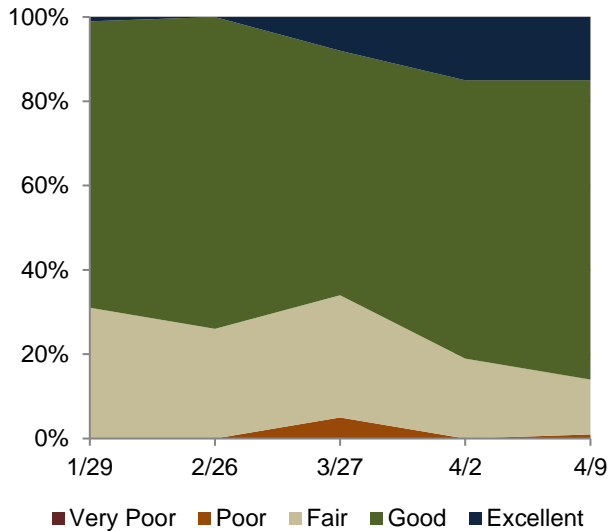

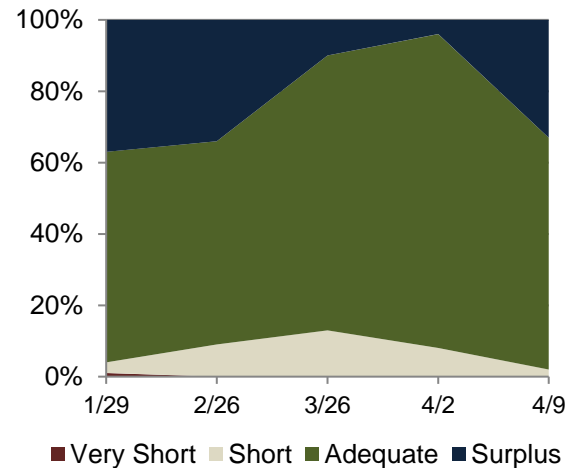

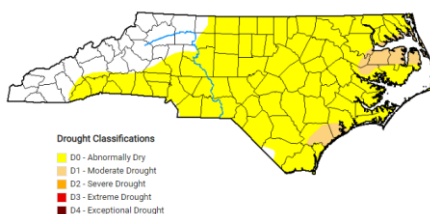
OAT CONDITION



TOPSOIL MOISTURE PERCENT

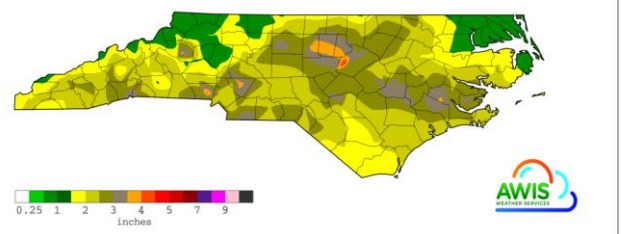


Map depicts current drought conditions as of April 4, 2023.
