











WHEAT STOCKS (Thousand Bushels)




CORN STOCKS (Thousand Bushels)



MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR SOYBEANS



(Dollars per Bushel)











CORN PLANTINGS (Thousand Acres)




PEANUT growers intend to plant 135,000 acres in 2025, up 4% from 2024.


WINTER WHEAT plantings totaled 360,000 acres, down 12% from last year.




SOYBEAN PLANTINGS (Thousand Acres)

SOWS FARROWING

North Carolina producers intend to farrow 395,000 sows during the March – May 2025 quarter and 395,000 sows during the June – August 2025 quarter.

The number of pigs saved per litter averaged 11.50 head, up 3% from the same quarter last year.


