






MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR SOYBEANS

Corn plantings are expected to total 910,000 acres in 2025, up 2% from 2024.


Flue-cured tobacco growers expect to harvest 115,000 acres in 2025, up 1% from 2024.

Winter wheat plantings totaled 360,000 acres, down 12% from last year.


MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR CORN






NC CORN FOR GRAIN (Thousand Acres)




NC SOYBEANS (Thousand Acres)

NC UPLAND COTTON (Thousand Acres)







SOWS FARROWING

North Carolina producers intend to farrow 395,000 sows during the June–August 2025 quarter and 380,000 sows during the September–November 2025 quarter.

PIG CROP

The State's pig crop during the March–May 2025 period totaled 4.543 million head, up slightly from the same period last year.

North Carolina's Pig Crop currently ranks 2nd nationally, behind Iowa, as of June 1, 2025.

PIGS PER LITTER

Pigs saved per litter during the March-May 2025 period averaged 11.80, which is up from the 11.35 pigs saved during the same quarter last year.

HOGS & PIGS TOTAL INVENTORY

The total inventory (includes breeding and market hogs) of hogs and pigs on North Carolina farms on June 1, 2025, totaled 7.8 million head, up 3% from last year.

North Carolina currently ranks 3rd nationally, behind Iowa and Minnesota, in the total inventory of hogs and pigs on farms as of June 1, 2025.
