









## UPLAND COTTON YIELD (Pounds)





Cotton production on December 1, 2024 is estimated at 750,000 480-pound bales, UP 4% from 2023.


## COTTON GINNINGS - RUNNING BALES GINNED (Year to Date)





#### MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR SOYBEANS



#### MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR WINTER WHEAT


