North Dakota Agricultural Statistics: Issued annually in August. Comprehensive book of state/county agricultural statistics. Available by mail subscription (\$12.00 or complimentary to farm operators) and updated each August on the Internet.

North Dakota Crop Progress and Condition Release: Released weekly April through November; monthly December to March. Reports crop progress and conditions, weather and farm activities. Available by e-mail subscription (free) and kept current on the Internet.

News Releases: Available free by e-mail subscription to the public and kept current on the Internet.

2012 Census of Agriculture: Comprehensive state and national data about production agriculture. Available by mail and on the Internet.

2012 Census of Agriculture Data Products

Every five years, the Census of Agriculture snaps a picture of America's farm and ranch industry at the county, state, and national levels. As the prime source of consistent, comparable, detailed data about production agriculture, census data provide a basis for determining both the present state of agriculture and trends over time. Volume 1, Geographic Area Series

United States, State and County Data - The United States Summary provides national data and selected data for each state. Separate state reports display statistics for the entire state and every county.

Volume 2, Subject Series

ZIP Code and Congressional District Tabulations - Presents agricultural statistics by five-digit postal ZIP Code and Congressional district in two separate files, for all farms in all 50 states.

Agricultural Atlas of the United States - Features a series of maps highlighting agricultural activities and characteristics.

Watershed Tabulations – Presents agricultural statistics by 6-digit Hydrological Unit Code for the contiguous 48 states, Alaska and Hawaii.

Census of Agriculture History – Provides a description of the planning and conduct of the 2012 Census of Agriculture. Explains the history of the agriculture census, farm definition, data collection and processing, data dissemination, research, and the census of agriculture in outlying areas.

Volume 3, Special Studies

2013 Farm and Ranch Irrigation Survey - Displays results from a sample survey of farm and ranch operators who reported using irrigation in the 2012 census.

2014 Organic Production Survey - Provides data on organic agriculture to determine how the growth of organic farming is changing the face of U.S. agriculture.
