## NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**FARGO, N.D. November 18, 2024** - For the week ending November 17, 2024, there were 5.9 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 14% very short, 41% short, 43% adequate, and 2% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 14% very short, 39% short, 45% adequate, and 2% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 3% very poor, 25% poor, 20% fair, 45% good, and 7% excellent.

Corn harvested was 95%, ahead of 84% last year and 79% for the five-year average.

Sunflowers harvested was 86%, ahead of 68% last year and 75% average.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 11% very poor, 33% poor, 28% fair, 27% good, and 1% excellent.

Stock water supplies rated 12% very short, 30% short, 56% adequate, and 2% surplus.
