## NORTH DAKOTA CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

**FARGO, N.D., July 12, 2021** - Based on July 1 conditions, North Dakota's 2021 **other spring wheat** crop is forecast at 161 million bushels, down 42% from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 28 bushels per acre, down 21 bushels from 2020. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 5.75 million acres, up 2% from a year ago.

**Durum wheat** production is forecast at 16.0 million bushels, down 55% from last year. Average yield is forecast at 22 bushels per acre, down 17 bushels from 2020. Area to be harvested for grain is expected to total 725,000 acres, down 20% from a year ago.

**Winter wheat** production is forecast at 1.93 million bushels, up 19% from last year. Average yield is forecast at 35 bushels per acre, down 14 bushels from 2020. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 55,000 acres, up 67% from a year ago.

**Barley** production is forecast at 18.2 million bushels, down 37% from last year. Average yield is forecast at 38 bushels per acre, 25 bushels lower than 2020. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 480,000 acres, up 4% from last year.

**Oat** production is forecast at 3.34 million bushels, down 59% from last year. Average yield is forecast at 47 bushels per acre, down 31 bushels from 2020. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 71,000 acres, down 32% from a year ago.
