NORTH DAKOTA JUNE 1, 2019 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. June 28, 2019 - North Dakota **corn** stocks stored in all positions on June 1, 2019 totaled 145 million bushels, down 12 percent from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 115 million bushels are down 4 percent from 2018, and off-farm stocks of 29.7 million bushels are down 34 percent from last year.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 149 million bushels, up 50 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 91.0 million bushels are up 60 percent from 2018, and off-farm stocks of 58.0 million bushels are up 38 percent from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 22.3 million bushels, up 45 percent from a year ago.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 19.4 million bushels, down 30 percent from 2018. On-farm stocks are 6.20 million bushels, down 50 percent from last year, and off-farm stocks, at 13.2 million bushels, are down 13 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 90.2 million bushels, up 102 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 38.5 million bushels, are up 126 percent from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 51.7 million bushels, are up 87 percent from 2018.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 1.94 million bushels, up 6 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 1.50 million bushels, are down 6 percent from a year ago, but off-farm stocks of 438,000 bushels, are up 90 percent from 2018.
