NORTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2019 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. September 30, 2019 - All wheat stored in all positions in North Dakota on September 1, 2019 totaled 378 million bushels, up 14 percent from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 280 million are up 31 percent from 2018, while off-farm stocks, at 98.2 million bushels, are down 17 percent from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 38.3 million bushels, up slightly from a year ago. Of the total, 31.0 million bushels are stored on-farm, while 7.29 million bushels are stored off-farm.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 37.7 million bushels, up 2 percent from 2018. On-farm stocks are 24.0 million bushels, up 30 percent from last year, while off-farm stocks, at 13.7 million bushels, are 26 percent below last year.

Corn stocks totaled 46.0 million bushels, down 24 percent from a year ago. Of the total, 15.0 million bushels are stored on farms, down 36 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 31.0 million bushels, are down 16 percent from last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 39.8 million bushels, up 150 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 16.0 million bushels, are up 321 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 23.8 million bushels, are up 96 percent from 2018.

Oat stocks totaled 6.05 million bushels. On-farm stocks, at 4.70 million bushels, are up 18 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks were 1.35 million bushels.

All sunflowers stored in all positions totaled 145 million pounds, down 18 percent from 2018. Of the total, 25.5 million pounds are stored on farms, up 12 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 120 million bushels, are down 22 percent from last year.

Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 100 million pounds, down 18 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 23.0 million pounds, are up 10 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 77.4 million pounds, are down 24 percent from last year.

Non-Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 44.9 million pounds, down 17 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks, at 2.50 million pounds, are up 47 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 42.4 million pounds, are down 19 percent from last year.
