NORTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2020 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. September 30, 2020 - All wheat stored in all positions in North Dakota on September 1, 2020 totaled 309 million bushels, down 10% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 225 million are down 8% from 2019, while off-farm stocks, at 83.7 million bushels, are down 15% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 25.0 million bushels, down 27% from a year ago. Of the total, 20.0 million bushels are stored on-farm, down 26% from last year, while 5.04 million bushels are stored off-farm, down 31% from 2019.

Barley On-farm stocks are 19.0 million bushels, down 19% from last year.

Corn stocks totaled 91.5 million bushels, up 88% from a year ago. Of the total, 40.0 million bushels are stored on farms, up 150% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 51.5 million bushels, are up 57% from last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 34.5 million bushels, down 13% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 10.5 million bushels, are down 34% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 24.0 million bushels, are up 1% from 2019.

Oat On-farm stocks, at 7.40 million bushels, are up 100% from a year ago.

All sunflowers stored in all positions totaled 89.1 million pounds, down 39% from 2019. Of the total, 3.30 million pounds are stored on farms, down 87% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 85.8 million bushels, are down 28% from last year.

Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 63.0 million pounds, down 37% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 1.40 million pounds, are down 94% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 61.6 million pounds, are down 20% from last year.

Non-Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 26.1 million pounds, down 42% from a year ago. On-farm stocks, at 1.90 million pounds, are down 24% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 24.2 million pounds, are down 43% from last year.
