NORTH DAKOTA MARCH 1, 2021 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. March 31, 2021 - North Dakota **corn** stocks stored in all positions on March 1, 2021 totaled 157 million bushels, down 41% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 81.0 million bushels are down 60% from 2020, but off-farm stocks of 76.4 million bushels are up 20% from last year.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 200 million bushels, down 1% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 107 million bushels are down 18% from 2020, but off-farm stocks of 93.4 million bushels are up 29% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 18.1 million bushels, down 12% from a year ago.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 24.5 million bushels, up 1% from 2020. On-farm stocks are 12.5 million bushels, unchanged from last year but off-farm stocks, at 12.0 million bushels, are up 2% from last year.

Oat on-farm stocks of 2.80 million bushels, are up 27% from a year ago.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 42.4 million bushels, down 47% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 17.5 million bushels, are down 62% from a year ago and off-farm stocks, at 24.9 million bushels, are down 27% from 2020.

All sunflower stored in all positions totaled 572 million pounds, up 53% from 2020. **Oil sunflower** stocks are 464 million pounds, up 39% from last year. **Non-oil sunflower** stocks of 108 million pounds, are up 177% from a year ago.
