NORTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. September 30, 2021 - **All wheat** stored in all positions in North Dakota on September 1, 2021 totaled 199 million bushels, down 36% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 99.0 million bushels are down 56% from 2020, while off-farm stocks, at 99.6 million bushels, are up 18% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 16.8 million bushels, down 34% from a year ago. Of the total, 12.5 million bushels are stored on-farm, down 38% from last year, while 4.30 million bushels are stored off-farm, down 22% from 2020.

Barley stocks totaled 24.7 million bushels. Of the total, on-farm stocks are 13.0 million bushels, down 32% from last year, while off-farm stocks totaled 11.7 million bushels.

Corn stocks totaled 27.5 million bushels, down 68% from a year ago. Of the total, 5.20 million bushels are stored on farms, down 87% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 22.3 million bushels, are down 52% from last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 7.15 million bushels, down 79% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 1.90 million bushels, are down 82% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 5.25 million bushels, are down 78% from 2020.

Oat on-farm stocks, at 3.40 million bushels, are down 54% from a year ago.

All sunflowers stored in all positions totaled 167 million pounds, up 87% from 2020. Of the total, 20.6 million pounds are stored on farms, up 524% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 146 million pounds, are up 71% from last year.

Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 114 million pounds, up 81% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 15.5 million pounds, are up 1,007% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 98.3 million pounds, are up 60% from last year.

Non-Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 53.3 million pounds, up 104% from a year ago. On-farm stocks, at 5.10 million pounds, are up 168% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 48.2 million pounds, are up 99% from last year.
