NORTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2023 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. September 29, 2023 - All wheat stored in all positions in North Dakota on September 1, 2023 totaled 257 million bushels, down 7% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 175 million are down 17% from 2022, while off-farm stocks, at 82.1 million bushels, are up 25% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 22.9 million bushels, up slightly from a year ago. Of the total, 18.0 million bushels are stored on-farm, down 3% from last year, while 4.86 million bushels are stored off-farm, up 13% from 2022.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 43.0 million bushels. On-farm stocks are 30.0 million bushels, down 21% from last year. Off-farm stocks totaled 13.0 million bushels.

Corn stocks totaled 36.6 million bushels, down 23% from a year ago. Of the total, 13.0 million bushels are stored on farms, down 19% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 23.6 million bushels, are down 25% from last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 9.54 million bushels, up 33% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 3.20 million bushels, are up 338% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 6.34 million bushels, are down 2% from 2022.

Oat On-farm stocks, at 5.00 million bushels, are down 41% from a year ago.

All sunflowers stored in all positions totaled 188 million pounds, up 26% from 2022. Of the total, 53.4 million pounds are stored on farms, up 174% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 134 million bushels, are up 4% from last year.

Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 172 million pounds, up 70% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 50.0 million pounds, are up 178% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 122 million pounds, are up 46% from last year.

Non-Oil sunflower stocks in all positions are 16.2 million pounds, down 66% from a year ago. On-farm stocks, at 3.40 million pounds, are up 127% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 12.8 million pounds, are down 72% from last year.
