NORTH DAKOTA MARCH 1, 2024 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. March 28, 2024 - North Dakota **corn** stocks stored in all positions on March 1, 2024 totaled 263 million bushels, up 43% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 170 million bushels are up 81% from 2023, and off-farm stocks of 93.3 million bushels are up 3% from last year.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 176 million bushels, up 13% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 100 million bushels are up 12% from 2023, and off-farm stocks of 75.8 million bushels are up 15% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 14.1 million bushels, down 14% from a year ago. On-farm stocks are 10.0 million bushels, down 5% from last year and off-farm stocks, at 4.05 million bushels, are down 31% from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 34.6 million bushels, up 30% from 2023. On-farm stocks are 20.5 million bushels, up 64% from last year and off-farm stocks, at 14.1 million bushels, are up 1% from last year.

Oat on-farm stocks of 2.55 million bushels, are down 12% from a year ago.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 58.7 million bushels, up 50% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 32.5 million bushels, are up 41% from a year ago and off-farm stocks, at 26.2 million bushels, are up 63% from 2023.

All sunflower stored in all positions totaled 696 million pounds, up 24% from 2023. Oil sunflower stocks are 610 million pounds, up 27% from last year. Non-oil sunflower stocks of 85.6 million pounds, are up 8% from a year ago.
