NORTH DAKOTA POTATO SUMMARY

FARGO, N.D. September 27, 2023 - Final production for the 2022 **potato** crop totaled 21.8 million cwt, down 3% from 2021, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Planted acres for 2022 totaled 74,000, down 3% from 2021. Harvested area, at 72,500 acres, was down 3% from the previous year. Yield for all potatoes averaged 300 cwt in 2022, unchanged from the 2021 average yield.

The value of potatoes sold from the 2022 crop totaled \$264 million, up 8% from 2021. The marketing year average price was \$12.90 per cwt, up from \$11.50 for the 2021 crop.

Potatoes sold from the 2022 crop totaled 20.4 million cwt, down 3% from 2021. Sales accounted for 94% of production, up slightly from the 2021 crop.
