NORTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2013 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, ND, September 30, 2013 – **All wheat** stored in all positions on September 1, 2013 totaled 215.4 million bushels, down 12 percent from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 155.0 million are down 6 percent from 2012 while off-farm stocks of 60.4 million bushels are down 24 percent from last year.

Durum wheat stored totaled 33.8 million bushels, up slightly percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 28.5 million bushels are up 6 percent from 2012 while off-farm stocks of 5.3 million bushels are down 21 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 51.9 million bushels, down 5 percent from 2012. On-farm stocks are 30.0 million bushels, down 19 percent from last year while off-farm stocks, at 21.9 million bushels, are 25 percent above last year.

Corn stocks totaled 17.4 million bushels, up 36 percent from a year ago. Of the total, 4.3 million bushels are stored on farms, up 65 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 13.1 million bushels, are up 29 percent from last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 2.5 million bushels, down 19 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 1.0 million bushels, are down 9 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 1.5 million bushels, are down 24 percent from 2012.

Oat stocks totaled 6.2 million bushels, down 8 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 5.7 million bushels, are down 5 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 512,000 bushels, are down 31 percent from 2012.

All sunflowers stored in all positions totaled 224.3 million pounds, up 209 percent from 2012. **Oil sunflower** stocks are 198.2 million pounds, up 559 percent from last year. **Non-Oil sunflower** stocks are 26.1 million pounds, down 39 percent from a year ago.
