## **NORTH DAKOTA CROP PRODUCTION REPORT**

FARGO, ND, December 10, 2014 – **Dry edible bean** production in North Dakota is forecast at 8.80 million hundredweight (cwt) for 2014, up 24 percent from last year according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics.

Total planted acres for dry edible beans, at 630,000 acres, are up from 43 percent from 2013. Harvested acres, at 615,000 acres, are up 43 percent from last year. The statewide yield for 2014 is forecast at 1,430 pounds per acre, down 220 pounds from a year ago.
