NORTH DAKOTA MARCH 1, 2014 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, ND, March 31, 2014 – **Corn** stocks stored in all positions on March 1, 2014 totaled 193 million bushels, up 22 percent from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 110.0 million bushels were up 41 percent from 2013 and off-farm stocks of 82.6 million bushels are up 4 percent from last year.

All wheat stored on March 1, 2014 totaled 156 million bushels, up 8 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 87.0 million were unchanged from 2013 and off-farm stocks of 69.0 million bushels are up 21 percent from last year.

Durum wheat stored totaled 19.0 million bushels, down 14 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 12.5 million bushels are down 22 percent from 2013 and off-farm stocks of 6.50 million bushels are up 6 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 34.3 million bushels, down one percent from 2013. On-farm stocks are 16.0 million bushels, up 52 percent from last year and off-farm stocks, at 18.3 million bushels, are 24 percent below last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 28.3 million bushels, up 2 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 8.70 million bushels, are down 38 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 19.6 million bushels, are up 43 percent from 2013.

Oat stocks totaled 3.40 million bushels, down 16 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 2.70 million bushels, are down 21 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 695,000 bushels, are up 10 percent from 2013.

All Sunflower stocks totaled 373 million pounds, down 46 percent from last year.
