NORTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2014 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, ND, September 30, 2014 – **All wheat** stored in all positions on September 1, 2014 totaled 313 million bushels, up 43 percent from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 270 million are up 71 percent from 2013, while off-farm stocks, at 43.0 million bushels, are down 29 percent from last year.

Durum wheat stored totaled 33.4 million bushels, down 2 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 29.0 million bushels are unchanged from 2013, while off-farm stocks of 4.42 million bushels, are down 13 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 44.2 million bushels, down 14 percent from 2013. On-farm stocks are 25.0 million bushels, down 17 percent from last year, while off-farm stocks, at 19.2 million bushels, are 11 percent below last year.

Corn stocks totaled 58.9 million bushels, up 258 percent from a year ago. Of the total, 20.0 million bushels are stored on farms, up 365 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 38.9 million bushels, are up 220 percent from last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 1.30 million bushels, down 47 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 130,000 bushels, are down 87 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 1.17 million bushels, are down 19 percent from 2013.

Oat stocks totaled 8.29 million bushels, up 34 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 7.50 million bushels, are up 32 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 786,000 bushels, are up 65 percent from 2013.

All sunflowers stored in all positions totaled 105 million pounds, down 53 percent from 2013. **Oil sunflower** stocks are 63.4 million pounds, down 68 percent from last year. **Non-Oil sunflower** stocks are 41.3 million pounds, up 58 percent from a year ago.
