NORTH DAKOTA JUNE 1 POTATO STOCKS

FARGO, ND, June 17, 2014 – North Dakota growers, dealers, and processors held 1.8 million hundredweight (cwt) of potatoes in storage on June 1, according to USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Current stocks represent 8 percent of the production. Total stocks are defined as all potatoes on hand, regardless of use, including those that will be lost through future shrinkage and dumping.
