## NORTH DAKOTA MARCH 1, 2015 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, ND, March 31, 2015 – **Corn** stocks stored in all positions on March 1, 2015 totaled 176 million bushels, down nine percent from a year ago, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 105 million bushels were down five percent from 2014 and off-farm stocks of 70.8 million bushels are down 15 percent from last year.

**All wheat** stored on March 1, 2015 totaled 163 million bushels, up four percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 105 million are up 21 percent from 2014 while off-farm stocks of 57.6 million bushels are down 17 percent from last year.

**Durum wheat** stored totaled 14.9 million bushels, down 22 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 10.0 million bushels are down 20 percent from 2014 and off-farm stocks of 4.86 million bushels are down 25 percent from last year.

**Barley** stored in all positions totaled 34.7 million bushels, up one percent from 2014. On-farm stocks are 12.5 million bushels, down 22 percent from last year while off-farm stocks, at 22.2 million bushels, are 21 percent above last year.

**Soybean** stocks totaled 35.1 million bushels, up 22 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 19.5 million bushels, are up 124 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 15.6 million bushels, are down 22 percent from 2014.

**Oat** stocks totaled 3.57 million bushels, up six percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 2.90 million bushels, are up seven percent from a year ago and off-farm stocks were 673,000 bushels.

**All Sunflower** stored in all positions totaled 344 million pounds, down eight percent from 2014. **Oil Sunflower** stocks were 265 million pounds, down seven percent from last year. **Non-Oil Sunflower** stocks were 78.7 million pounds, down 11 percent from a year ago.
