NORTH DAKOTA JUNE 1, 2015 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, ND, June 30, 2015 – North Dakota **all wheat** stored in all positions on June 1, 2015 totaled 103 million bushels, up 25 percent from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 60.0 million are up 41 percent from 2014. Off-farm stocks of 42.5 million bushels are up 8 percent from last year. **Durum wheat** stored totaled 10.9 million bushels, down 1 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 7.70 million are down 16 percent from 2014. Off-farm stocks of 3.15 million bushels are up 79 percent from last year.

Corn stocks totaled 91.8 million bushels, down 30 percent from a year ago. Of the total, 58.0 million bushels are stored on farms, down 23 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 33.8 million bushels, are down 40 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 26.4 million bushels, down 1 percent from 2014. On-farm stocks are 7.7 million bushels, down 15 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks, at 18.7 million bushels, are 7 percent above last year.

Soybeans stored totaled 16.6 million bushels, up 17 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 10.0 million bushels, are up 376 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 6.58 million bushels, are down 46 percent from 2014.

Oats stored totaled 2.46 million bushels, up 20 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 2.25 million bushels, are up 36 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 212,000 bushels, are down 48 percent from 2014.
