NORTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2015 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, ND, September 30, 2015 – **All wheat** stored in all positions on September 1, 2015 totaled 322 million bushels, up 3 percent from a year ago, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 215 million are down 19 percent from 2014, while off-farm stocks, at 107 million bushels, are up 130 percent from last year.

Durum wheat stored totaled 35.1 million bushels, up 13 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 29.5 million bushels are up 11 percent from 2014, while off-farm stocks of 5.59 million bushels, are up 19 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 71.5 million bushels, up 63 percent from 2014. On-farm stocks are 49.5 million bushels, up 106 percent from last year, while off-farm stocks, at 22.0 million bushels, are 11 percent above last year.

Corn stocks totaled 42.0 million bushels, down 25 percent from a year ago. Of the total, 15.0 million bushels are stored on farms, down 25 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 27.0 million bushels, are down 24 percent from last year.

Soybean stocks totaled 4.51 million bushels, up 242 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 1.30 million bushels, are up 900 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 3.21 million bushels, are up 170 percent from 2014.

Oat stocks totaled 8.57 million bushels, up 13 percent from last year. On-farm stocks, at 7.80 million bushels, are up 15 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 773,000 bushels, are down 2 percent from 2014.

All sunflowers stored in all positions totaled 136 million pounds, up 31 percent from 2014. **Oil sunflower** stocks are 47.8 million pounds, down 23 percent from last year. **Non-Oil sunflower** stocks are 88.4 million pounds, up 114 percent from a year ago.
