NORTH DAKOTA FEBRUARY 1 POTATO STOCKS

FARGO, ND, February 17, 2015 – North Dakota growers, dealers, and processors held 12.4 million hundredweight (cwt) of potatoes in storage on February 1, according to USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Current stocks represent 84 percent of the production. Total stocks are defined as all potatoes on hand, regardless of use, including those that will be lost through future shrinkage and dumping.
