NORTH DAKOTA APRIL 1 POTATO STOCKS

FARGO, ND, April 18, 2016 – North Dakota growers, dealers, and processors held 9.2 million hundredweight (cwt) of potatoes in storage on April 1, according to USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Current stocks represent 33.8 percent of the 2015 production. Total stocks are defined as all potatoes on hand, regardless of use, including those that will be lost through future shrinkage and dumping.
