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NORTH DAKOTA CROP VALUES

FARGO, N.D. April 12, 2019 - The value of North Dakota's 2018 field and miscellaneous crops is forecast at \$7.42 billion, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This is up 8 percent from 2017.

The value of **soybean** production is expected to total \$2.02 billion, down 6 percent from the previous marketing year. Soybean price is projected to average \$8.30 per bushel, down \$0.58 from the last marketing year.

The value of **spring wheat** production is expected to total \$1.65 billion, up 40 percent from the previous marketing year. Spring wheat price is projected to average \$5.20 per bushel, down \$0.52 from the last marketing year.
