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NORTH DAKOTA CROP VALUES

FARGO, N.D. February 25, 2021 - The value of North Dakota's 2020 field and miscellaneous crops is forecast at \$6.83 billion, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This is up 17% from 2019.

The value of **corn** production is expected to total \$1.05 billion, down 16% from the previous marketing year. North Dakota's corn price is projected to average \$4.25 per bushel, up \$1.18 from the last marketing year.

The value of **soybean** production is expected to total \$2.04 billion, up 51% from the previous marketing year. North Dakota's soybean price is projected to average \$10.70 per bushel, up \$2.77 from the last marketing year.

The value of **spring wheat** production is expected to total \$1.38 billion, up 7% from the previous marketing year. North Dakota's spring wheat price is projected to average \$5.00 per bushel, up \$0.56 from the last marketing year.
