## NORTH DAKOTA ORGANIC AGRICULTURE

**Fargo, ND** – The U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Statistics Service has released the results of its 2015 Certified Organic Survey. Certified organic operations in North Dakota sold a total of \$21.3 million in organic products in 2015, down 22 percent compared to 2014. The number of certified organic operations in North Dakota increased 6 percent to 100 during this time.

The 2015 Certified Organic Survey collected acreage, production, and sales data for a variety of certified organic crop and livestock commodities. In addition, the survey collected information on genetically modified organisms and genetically engineered presence, marketing practices, future planning, and transitional acreage.
