AGRICULTURAL PRICES

FARGO, ND, August 30, 2013 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for spring wheat for August 2013 averaged \$6.90 per bushel, a decrease of 19 cents from the July price according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Durum wheat, at \$7.90 per bushel, decreased 13 cents from the previous month. Winter wheat averaged \$6.25 per bushel, a decrease of 25 cents from July.

The preliminary August feed barley price, at \$3.80 per bushel, was down \$1.16 from last month. The malting barley price, at \$6.05, was down 38 cents from last month.

The preliminary August oat price, at \$3.75 per bushel, increased 7 cents from last month.

The preliminary August corn price, at \$5.50 per bushel, decreased 87 cents from last month.

The preliminary August soybean price, at \$12.70 per bushel, was down \$1.70 from last month.

The preliminary August all dry edible bean price, at \$39.20 per cwt, decreased 50 cents from last month. The pinto price for July averaged \$40.30 per cwt while the navy price averaged \$37.30 per cwt.

The preliminary August all sunflowers price, at \$24.00 per cwt, was down 30 cents from the previous month.

The preliminary August flaxseed price, at \$13.10 per bushel, was down \$2.00 from last month.

The preliminary August canola price averaged \$24.00 per cwt, a decrease of \$2.10 from July.

The August alfalfa hay price, at \$115.00 per ton, was down \$2.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$77.00 per ton, was up \$2.00 from last month.

The preliminary August prices for fresh and processing potatoes were withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.
