## **NORTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES**

FARGO, ND, October 31, 2013 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for spring wheat for October 2013 averaged \$6.85 per bushel, an increase of 22 cents from the September price according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Durum wheat, at \$7.25 per bushel, decreased 67 cents from the previous month. Winter wheat averaged \$6.60 per bushel, an increase of 8 cents from September.

The preliminary October feed barley price, at \$3.15 per bushel, is down 46 cents from last month. The malting barley price, at \$6.30, is down 19 cents from last month.

The preliminary October oat price, at \$3.30 per bushel, increased 7 cents from last month.

The preliminary October corn price, at \$4.25 per bushel, decreased \$1.42 from last month.

The preliminary October soybean price, at \$12.10 per bushel, decreased 50 cents from last month.

The preliminary October all dry edible bean price, at \$37.20 per cwt, decreased 40 cents from last month. The pinto price for September averaged \$37.40 per cwt while the navy price averaged \$36.20 per cwt.

The preliminary October all sunflowers price, at \$20.50 per cwt, is down \$3.80 from the previous month.

The preliminary October flaxseed price, at \$13.20 per bushel, is up 10 cents from last month.

The preliminary October canola price averaged \$19.80 per cwt, a decrease of 90 cents from September.

The October alfalfa hay price, at \$108.00 per ton, is down \$10.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$68.00 per ton, is down \$8.00 from last month.

The preliminary October prices for fresh and processing potatoes were withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.
