NORTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES

FARGO, ND, January 31, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for spring wheat for January 2014 averaged \$5.95 per bushel, a decrease of 22 cents from the December price according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Durum wheat, at \$6.65 per bushel, decreased 21 cents from the previous month. Winter wheat averaged \$5.75 per bushel, a decrease of 23 cents from December.

The preliminary January feed barley price, at \$4.10 per bushel, is down 23 cents from last month. The malting barley price, at \$6.00, is down 62 cents from last month.

The preliminary January corn price, at \$3.95 per bushel, decreased 13 cents from last month.

The preliminary January soybean price, at \$12.40 per bushel, decreased 20 cents from last month.

The preliminary January all dry edible bean price, at \$35.10 per cwt, decreased \$1.30 cents from last month. The pinto price for December averaged \$36.60 per cwt while the navy price averaged \$36.50 per cwt.

The preliminary January all sunflowers price, at \$23.10 per cwt, is up 30 cents from the previous month.

The preliminary January canola price averaged \$18.00 per cwt, a decrease of \$3.10 from December.

The January alfalfa hay price, at \$104.00 per ton, is unchanged from last month. The other hay price, at \$71.00 per ton, is up \$3.00 from last month.

The preliminary January prices for flaxseed and oats as well as fresh and processing potatoes were withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.
