## **NORTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES**

FARGO, ND, June 27, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for spring wheat for June 2014 averaged \$6.20 per bushel, a decrease of 51 cents from the May price according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Durum wheat, at \$7.63 per bushel, increased 53 cents from the previous month. Winter wheat averaged \$6.30 per bushel, a decrease of 30 cents from May.

The preliminary June feed barley price, at \$3.60 per bushel, is down 12 cents from last month. The malting barley price, at \$6.00, is down 26 cents from last month.

The preliminary June corn price, at \$3.70 per bushel, decreased 51 cents from last month.

The preliminary June soybean price, at \$13.00 per bushel, is down 20 cents from last month.

The preliminary June all dry edible bean price, at \$30.60 per cwt, decreased \$1.10 from last month. The pinto price for May averaged \$30.20 per cwt.

The preliminary June all sunflowers price, at \$24.60 per cwt, is down 70 cents from the previous month.

The preliminary June flaxseed price, at \$14.50 per bushel, is down 40 cents from last month.

The preliminary June canola price averaged \$21.50 per cwt, a decrease of 20 cents from May.

The June alfalfa hay price, at \$91.00 per ton, is down \$8.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$57.00 per ton, is down \$7.00 from last month.

The preliminary June prices for oats as well as fresh and processing potatoes were withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual operations. The navy bean price for May was also withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.
