## **NORTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES**

FARGO, ND, November 26, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for spring wheat for November 2014 averaged \$5.48 per bushel, an increase of 34 cents from the October price according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Durum wheat, at \$8.75 per bushel, increased 14 cents from the previous month. Winter wheat averaged \$4.78 per bushel, an increase of 50 cents from October.

The preliminary November feed barley price, at \$2.50 per bushel, is down 50 cents from last month. The malting barley price, at \$5.49, is down 7 cents from last month.

The preliminary November corn price, at \$3.14 per bushel, increased 3 cents from last month.

The preliminary November soybean price, at \$9.50 per bushel, is down 8 cents from last month.

The preliminary November all dry edible bean price, at \$25.10 per cwt, decreased \$3.00 from last month. The pinto price for October averaged \$26.60 per cwt while the navy price averaged 31.10 per cwt.

The preliminary November all sunflowers price, at \$21.50 per cwt, is up \$2.00 from the previous month.

The preliminary November flaxseed price, at \$11.10 per bushel, is down 40 cents from last month.

The preliminary November canola price averaged \$16.30 per cwt, an increase of 70 cents from October.

The November alfalfa hay price, at \$83.00 per ton, is up \$3.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$59.00 per ton, is up \$4.00 from last month.

The preliminary November prices for oats as well as fresh and processing potatoes were withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.
