## COUNTY ESTIMATES

**N**orth Dakota Cavalier County led all North Dakota counties in spring wheat production in 2006 with 14.2 million bushels, up from fourth place in 2005. There were 363,000 acres harvested for grain in Cavalier County, which averaged 39.2 bushels per acre. Ward County moved up to second place from third in 2005, with 11.1 million bushels produced. In third place, Pembina County produced 9.51 million bushels.

Williams County topped all North Dakota counties in durum wheat production for the sixth consecutive year, with 6.46 million bushels. Acres harvested for grain totaled 282,000, with an average yield of 22.9 bushels. Divide County came in second, with 5.82 million bushels produced, followed by Mountrail County, with 3.88 million bushels.

The largest barley producing county in North Dakota for the sixth consecutive year was Bottineau County, with 5.25 million bushels harvested from 97,000 acres. The average yield for Bottineau County


was 54.1 bushels. Ramsey County came in second, with 3.61 million bushels produced. In third place, Renville County produced 3.21 million bushels.

The top corn for grain producing county in 2006 was again Richland County, with 29.6 million bushels from 214,000 harvested acres. The average yield in Richland County was 138.5 bushels per harvested acre. Cass County remained in second place with 17.2 million bushels harvested from 137,000 acres. In third place, Dickey County produced 13.0 million bushels.

The largest soybean producing county in North Dakota was again Cass County, with 19.0 million bushels harvested from 539,000 acres. Cass County was also the Nation's number one producing soybean county for 2006 in both acreage and total production. The average yield for Cass County was 35.3 bushels. Richland County moved up to second place with 11.7 million bushels produced. It was followed by Stutsman County, with 10.9 million bushels.

Cavalier County topped all North Dakota counties in canola production, with 335 million pounds, more than triple the next highest county. Acres harvested for grain totaled 192,500, with an average yield of 1,739 pounds. Towner County came in second, with 108 million pounds produced, followed by Ward County, with 96.7 million pounds.

### Corn for Grain: Production North Dakota, 2006




### Spring Wheat: Production North Dakota, 2006


## POTATO STOCKS

**N**orth Dakota Growers, dealers and processors held 9.50 million hundredweight (cwt) of potatoes in storage March 1, 2007, up 32 percent from a year ago but down 27 percent from the record high two years ago of 13.1 million cwt. Current stocks represent 37 percent of production, up from 35 percent last year but down from 49 percent two years ago. Total stocks are defined as all potatoes on hand, regardless of use, including those that will be lost through future shrinkage and dumping.

Disappearance from the start of harvest to March 1 totaled 16.0 million cwt, up from 13.3 million cwt a year ago and 13.7 million cwt two years ago. February disappearance totaled 2.50 million cwt, up from 2.20 million cwt a year ago and two years ago.

**U**nited States The 13 major potato states held 153 million cwt of potatoes in storage March 1, 2007, down 1 percent from last year and 8 percent below March 1, 2005, for comparable states. Potatoes in storage account for 40 percent of the 2006 fall storage states' production, down 2 percent from last year.

Disappearance of 229 million cwt from the start of harvest to March 1, is up 5 percent from last year. Shrink and loss, at 20.1 million cwt, is up 9 percent from the previous year. Processors have used 125 million cwt of 2006 crop potatoes so far this season, up 9 percent from a year ago and 5 percent above 2 years ago. Dehydrating usage accounts for 25.6 million cwt of the total processing, up 12 percent from last year but 2 percent below the same date in 2005.
