North Dakota Milk Production

Fargo, ND – Milk production in North Dakota during the January – March 2016 quarter totaled 83 million pounds, up 4 percent from 80 million pounds during the same period a year earlier, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 16,000 head, unchanged from the same period last year.
